One of more 17 simple larger-than-life stick figure sculptures is unloaded in New Orleans, Monday, May 6, 2013. The statues will be used to call attention to evacuation pickup points around New Orleans for residents who need transportation out of town when a hurricane evacuation is ordered. The figures were designed by Boston artist Douglas Kornfeld, bottom center, who was selected for the work by the Arts Council of New Orleans. 


